New asphalt shingles, new gutters, 6 new downspouts, and gutter guards.

High school air-infiltration project

Seal up abandoned exhaust fans and other cold air entry points from the previous HVAC system, including the wall uninvents.

Finish the exterior of the building in similar brick to match the existing brick color and style.

Middle school energy conservation project

As of November of 2020, MMS had an energy star rating of "1". Contacted Heapy Engineering, perform a complete evaluation of the building systems and HVAC controls.

The plan was to re-engineer the control sequencing to better manage the HVAC and control the amount of outside air as well as the schedule of the building to ensure the system is on when the building is being used and the system is "less active" when the building is not being used.

The plan called for a one year period of monitoring the utility bills to ensure the plan is working and our staff could run the controls properly.
